The Tournament is sanctioned by the LTA and will be conducted under their current rules. Entrants to all singles events must be LTA registered members and have a rating. ITF approved balls will be used.

Rating application forms are available from the Tournament Referee.

Entries will be accepted on a 'first come, first served' basis up to the limit of the capacity of the courts available for the Tournament. Entries will not be accepted unless accompanied by the correct entry fee. The draw will take place at 11am on Saturday 27th March at Tunbridge Wells Lawn Tennis Club.

The tournament Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry without stating a reason.

Competitors must be at the ground, ready to play, when required, or they are liable to be scratched. Competitors must be available to play on the finals day and are reminded that they are not permitted to play in another tournament at the same time as the Tunbridge Wells tournament.

All singles matches, apart from Round Robins and younger age groups, will be the best of three sets, with a tie-break at 6 all in all 3 sets.

Competitors will be advised of their first match by the Referee by email, and should make sure their email address is correct on the LTA records.

The draw and match times will also be available on the following website **www.lta.tournamentsoftware.com** from Wednesday 31st March 2010.

The decision of the Referee is final. No complaint in connection with the Tournament can be considered by the Committee unless made in writing to the Tournament Secretary within 48 hours of its occurrence. No appeal against any decision of the Committee can be considered by the LTA Council, unless made in writing to the LTA within 10 days after receipt of the decision.

Players wishing to leave the ground before the end of a days play must ask the permission of the Referee. Players not available for play when called are liable to disqualification.

Recognised tennis clothing must be worn on court. Rubber soled shoes, without raised heels, ribbing or spikes, must be worn.

Competitors indulging in bad behaviour or using bad language, whether on or off the court, are liable to be reported to the LTA.

Players enter the tournament at their own risk and neither the Club, nor Kent County LTA shall be held responsible for personal injury or loss or damage to personal effects.

Tarmacadam courts will be used, or other outside courts may be used if necessary. Floodlights will be used if required.
