The Tournament is sanctioned by the LTA and will be conducted under their current rules. Entrants to all singles events must be British Tennis Members and have an LTA player rating. These can be obtained by calling the British Tennis membership department on 0208 487 7000. We cannot accept applications if British Tennis Membership and player rating allocation have not been finalised. ITF approved balls will be used.

Rating application forms are available from the Tournament Referee.

If the tournament capacity is exceeded by the number of applications, with the exception of mini tennis events, priority will be given to entrants with the highest rating. Acceptance of players of equal rating will be allocated to those with the highest ranking. Acceptance and seeding of all mini events will be determined by the local LTA Talent Performance team. Entries will only be accepted with the correct entry fee. Telephone entries will not be accepted. The draw will take place at 8pm on Tuesday 10th August at Tunbridge Wells Lawn Tennis Club.

The tournament Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry without stating a reason.

Competitors must be at the ground, ready to play, when required, or they are liable to be disqualified. Competitors must be available to play on the finals day. **Please note we are unable to accept applications from any entrants playing in another tournament during the same week - except mini tennis players entering events taking place on days which do not clash with ours.**

All main draw singles matches, apart from Round Robins and younger age groups, will be the best of three sets, with a tie-break at 6 all in all 3 sets. The referee reserves the right to change the scoring format of any event at any time during the tournament to an alternative which still qualifies for singles ratings.

Each player is responsible for finding out when they are due to play throughout the tournament by checking the 'Tournament Information' document on the LTA website (KEN102). We aim to email 'first match' times after midnight on Wednesday 11 August so please check your LTA records have your correct email address. Anyone without email can call the referee on 07532 016 095 (Thurs 12 August onwards). The draw will be published by midnight on Friday 13 August and can be accessed via the 'Tournament Information' document on the LTA website (KEN102).

The decision of the Referee is final. No complaint in connection with the Tournament can be considered by the Committee unless made in writing to the Tournament Secretary within 48 hours of its occurrence. No appeal against any decision of the Committee can be considered by the LTA Council, unless made in writing to the LTA within 10 days after receipt of the decision.

The LTA penalty point system (withdrawals and code violations) introduced 1 April 2010 will apply to all matches during this competition including consolation and doubles events. You may have more than one match a day even if you lose so please check with the referee before leaving as players unavailable when called to court are also liable to be disqualified.

Recognised tennis clothing which meets LTA clothing regulations must be worn on court. Rubber soled shoes, without raised heels, ribbing or spikes, must be worn.

Players and spectators should at all times whilst on the tournament site behave in an acceptable manner in accordance with the LTA Code of Conduct. Copies of which will be on site and can be emailed in advance on request from the referee. Any breach by a spectator or player may result in sanctions being applied to the player and removal from court side or the tournament site.

Players enter the tournament at their own risk and neither the Club, nor Kent County LTA shall be held responsible for personal injury or loss or damage to personal effects.

Grass, clay and tarmacadam courts will be used, and other outside courts as necessary. Floodlights will be used if required.
